Additionally, a quorum of votes had not been reached as of the original meeting date.

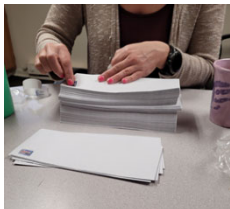
A letter noting these changes, along with an additional proxy statement, was mailed on April 20, 2021.

Changes to the Rawlins, Wyoming Operations

The Board of Directors made the decision at their March, 2021 regular monthly Board meeting to permanently close the Rawlins office. After substantial changes in November of 2020 the facility failed to rebound. Additionally, after a nationwide search for qualified therapists to provide services in Rawlins we were unable to hire anyone.

The building is being utilized by a women's clinic from Laramie approximately two days per week on a preexisting rental agreement. A property manager has been put in place who also provides janitorial services and security.

The building and the adjoining acreage currently is available for sale or lease.

As you know, Maserculiq, Incorporated is the **for-profit** Corporation organized under the **Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act of 1971 (ANCSA)** for the community of Marshall, Alaska.

Two Hundred and Sixteen (216) residents were originally enrolled as Shareholders for Maserculiq, Inc. and each Shareholder was allocated One Hundred (100) shares.

If you are a shareholder who has not completed a Last Will to control who will get your shares upon your death, you can still complete that document. Attached to this month's newsletter is a blank Stock Will. If you need assistance in completing the document please contact Rose Fitka at the Marshall office (907-679-6512).

When a Shareholder passes away, the Shareholder Records staff need specific documents to distribute the shares to the legal heirs. If you have received a letter from the Corporation office and/or can assist the Shareholder Records staff with obtaining documents from elderly parents, sibling and/or relatives to assure that undistributed shares are processed in a timely manner, please contact the main office in person, mail or email.

Without those necessary documents, we are unable to transfer the shares to the heirs. It is only after the shares have been transferred that the legal heirs of the Deceased Shareholders have the right to participate with the Corporate business affairs. This includes the right to vote during the Annual Shareholders Meeting for Shareholder representatives to serve on the Board of Directors. Dividends for shares that have not been transferred also cannot be distributed and are held by the Corporation.
